PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEWS

Parent/Teacher interviews will be held on Wednesday 26th June 2019 and **students will finish school at 12pm**. CHILDREN ARRIVING TO SCHOOL EARLY IN THE MORNING

We have noticed that there are a number of students arriving at school before 8am. Please note that teachers commence Yard Duty at 8:30am, however students are arriving much earlier. Students who arrive early to school are **not supervised** at this time. We have 'Before School Care' in the hall which commences at 7am and a 'Breakfast Club' in the Community Room which begins at 8:15am.

We all have a Duty of Care. Therefore teachers have been instructed to direct all unsupervised children (who arrive at school prior to 8:30am) to go to Before School Care or to the Breakfast Club for their safety.
