Gospel A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew (Mt 11:2-11)

LEARNING AND TEACHING

THE 2020 SCHOOL YEAR – LITERACY AND NUMERACY TESTING

Literacy and Numeracy testing provides teachers with important data to inform teaching and to enable teachers to target specific student needs. Over the past few years, Literacy and Numeracy testing took place at the beginning of Term 1 prior to the students commencing school. Last year we had moved the Literacy and Numeracy Testing to the end of Term 1, due to the large number of students who travel overseas with their families to celebrate the Lunar New Year.

As Term 1 in 2020 is only 8.5 weeks, we have decided as a staff to move the Literacy and Numeracy Testing to March, just before the Labour Day weekend. This will enable the teachers to have their data earlier and will allow them with sufficient time to submit it to Catholic Education Melbourne (CEM).

The changes for 2020 are as follows:

- Students in Grade 1 to Grade 6 will commence school on Wednesday 29th January 2020 at 8:55am 3:15pm.
- Students in Grade Prep commence school on Thursday 30th January 2020 at 8:55am 12:15pm.
- Preps will finish at 12:15pm until Friday 7th February 2020. (Preps have no school on Wednesdays in February).
- Preps are at school from 8:55am to 3:15pm from Monday 10th February 2020.
- Literacy and Numeracy Testing will be held on Thursday 5th and Friday 6th March 2020 (Students will be given an appointment time School Closure Days).
- Parent/Teacher Chats will be held on Wednesday 18th March 2020. (All students finish at 12pm).

Testing in the middle of Term 1 will mean that:

- Students and their families will have arrived back from their overseas holiday.
- Students will have had the opportunity to settle into their new grades and will have met their teacher.
- Class teachers will have had the opportunity to meet parents in order to assist students in their class.
- Teachers have sufficient time to submit Literacy and Numeracy testing to CEM.

HOLY EUCHARIST SCHOOL IN 2020 - GRADE PREP

Next year we will have approximately 95 Preps attending Holy Eucharist school. During Orientation Day, the students met all the prep teachers and fellow prep students, however they were not assigned to a class or a teacher for 2020. In order to accommodate for all of these students and to cater to their individual needs, prep students will be allocated a grade and teacher in mid February 2020. This will enable the teachers to get to know the students and to evenly distribute students across the four grades according to their needs. By Friday 14th February 2020 classlists should be ready and teachers will be able to advise parents as to who will be their child's grade prep teacher.

All Prep classes from Thursday 30th January until Friday 7th February will commence at 8:55am in the school Hall and will finish at 12:15pm. All Prep students will be required to bring their lunch on these days. Please remember <u>drop off and pick up your prep child</u> from the school Hall. From Monday 10th February Prep students will be at school from 8:55am until 3:15pm. **Prep students do not** have school on Wednesdays in February. School hats are compulsory in Term 1 and Term 4.

HOLY EUCHARIST SCHOOL IN 2020 - GRADES 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6

Term 1, 2020 commences on Wednesday 29th January at 8:55am until 3:15pm. School hats are compulsory in Term 1 and Term 4. A calendar for the whole year will be issued to families in February 2020. Please note the following dates for January and February 2020 in your diaries:


