Due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus, the school is taking a number of precautionary measures to ensure the safety of our students, parents and staff. These are outlined below:

### **Parent /Teacher Chats**

### **School Masses and Assemblies**

All school Thursday masses and school assemblies have been put on hold until further notice in order to limit the number of people gathering in the one space.

### **Sacraments**

The Archbishop of Melbourne Peter Comensoli has advised all parishes and schools that they are not to conduct any Confirmation celebrations. Therefore, all sacramental celebrations will be postponed until further notice. This also includes the parent meetings and reflection days.

### **Harmony Day and Day Against Bullying and Violence.**

The school originally planned to have an assembly and various activities throughout the day. These activities and assembly have been cancelled to minimise risk.

### **School Excursions/Camps/Inter-school sports.**

All school excursions and camps have been cancelled until further notice.

### **Community Hub.**

The Community Hub will be closed as of today until further notice.

### **Extra Curricula Activities.**

All extra curricula activities as outlined in the school calendar have been cancelled until further notice.

### **Student Attendance.**
