RELIGION

Unit: Belonging to God's People

Understandings:

- The Church is the family of God.

Unit: Lent

Understandings:

- Jesus teaches people about God's love.
- Jesus had followers called disciples.
- There are special days we celebrate during Holy Week.

ENGLISH

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Using 1:1 matching and directionality when reading.
- · Recognising where to start reading.
- Recognising that print is made up of letters, words and sentences.
- Understanding that print is different to pictures.
- Understanding that print contains meaning.
- Locating the front and back covers of a book.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Attempting to write their name.
- Understanding that speech can be written.
- Dictating or attempting to write a sentence based on their drawing.
- Attempting to write isolated letters or words.
- Attempting to hear and record initial letters with help.
- Attempting to write some letters using the correct letter formation.
- Developing fine motor skills using finger plays, play dough and scissors.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Communicating with others.
- Listening to others.
- Waiting and taking turns.
- Asking and answering simple questions using a given structure.
- Listening to and following oral instructions and stories.
- Sharing personal experiences with others.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

- · Counting forwards and backwards.
- Recognising numerals.
- Ordering numbers.
- Recognising, naming and sorting 2D shapes according to their attributes.
- Stating the days of the week.

INTEGRATED STUDES - INQUIRY

Topic: I Belong!

Learning Area: Humanities/ Geography

Big Question: What does it mean to belong?

Understandings:

- We belong to a family and a school community.
- Families do lots of things together.
- Different people make up our families.
- We each have a family name.
- Families celebrate different things together.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Learning how to follow simple instructions to keep themselves and others safe during physical activities.
- Practising a range of fundamental movement skills such as running, skipping, hopping, jumping and applying these skills to set movement based activity stations.
- Participating in various movement games and tasks that require them to communicate and cooperate with others.

THE ARTS

Visual Arts

Your child will be:

- Practising and reinforcing how to make primary and secondary colours to enhance their artworks.
- Learning to follow safety rules during art, such as: how to handle paint, brushes and scissors.
- Sticking coloured shapes to create "a community" mural using the elements of art (i.e. colour, shape, and line).

Music

Your child will be:

- Understanding basic beat (crotchets).
- Understanding basic rhythm (quavers).
- Recognising basic beat and rhythm in songs, chants and movement.

LOTE - Language Other Than English

Chinese – Mandarin

Your child will be:

- Learning about Chinese New Year, the Chinese Zodiac signs and the differences between the Oriental and Western calendar.
- Learning how to say simple Chinese greetings.

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Your child will be:

- Introduced to the subject Digital Technologies.
- Experimenting with using the mouse pad on the school's MacBooks.
