# Principal's Message:

Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians,

This term has produced so many challenges for all of us. The staff, students, parents, carers and guardians have all had an added element of stress due to the Coronavirus. It is really important that we all stay safe and follow the laws introduced by the Andrews Government. The school will officially open for Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2 on Tuesday May 26<sup>th</sup>. On Monday May 25<sup>th</sup>, the school will be closed for the teachers to prepare for the opening on Tuesday May 26<sup>th</sup>. NO STUDENTS ARE TO ATTEND SCHOOL ON THIS DAY. School will open for children in Grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June. These grade levels will continue to learn remotely until 9<sup>th</sup> June.

To follow the social distancing rules, the students will enter and leave the school at different gates depending on their grade level. These gates and grade levels will be outlined later on. Also, the starting and finishing times have been adjusted to avoid children and parents from gathering together. At no time are parents allowed to enter the school grounds. If parents need to speak to a teacher or administration staff they must make an appointment by calling the office on **8312 0900**.

All of these changes are needed to meet the criteria set out by the State Government and to keep all of us safe.

#### **BACK TO SCHOOL**

Holy Eucharist School will commence with a staggered return from remote and flexible learning from Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2020. In order for staff to prepare for this transition, Monday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2020 will be a **student-free day**. The student-free day will enable staff to plan for a successful transition to school. The return to school will take place in two stages. These are as follows:

> Stage 1: Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> May – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020 (*Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2*)

Starting Time: 8:40am - 9:00am

Finishing time: 2:50pm

School Entrance and Pick up Zone: Each grade level will have a designated gate to enter/leave the school.

In the first stage, students in Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2 will **return to school from Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> May.** Remote and flexible learning will continue for all students in Grades 3 to Grade 6 until Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June.

During Stage 1, the existing model of onsite schooling for students who cannot be supervised at home and vulnerable children will remain in place.

Stage 2: Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020 (Grade 3, Grade 4, Grade 5, Grade 6)

Starting Time: 9:05am - 9:20am

Finishing time: 3:15pm

School Entrance and Pick up Zone: Each grade level will have a designated gate to enter/leave the school.

All other year levels will return to school from Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June. All students will be expected to attend school as normal. Outdoor education schools and camps, leadership schools, tech schools, maths and science specialist centres, the Victorian School of Languages (VSL) and community language schools (CLSs) will remain closed for face-to-face provision (with the exception of the VSL and CLSs for VCE students). This is to avoid extensive contact between students from different schools. Further advice will be provided about their operation in the week of 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.

There will be more information provided in the coming weeks.

## THE ROSARY

Pope Francis is encouraging everyone to pray the Rosary during the month of May, especially during the pandemic. The Rosary is a special prayer and devotion to Our Lady. It is also a church tradition to pray the Rosary on your own or with the family. Traditionally the church honours Mary – "Queen of heaven and earth" during the month of May.



#### **CLASS DOJO**

Class Dojo is an educational technology communication app and website. It connects primary school teachers, students and families through communication features, such as a feed for photos and videos from the school day, and messaging that can be translated into more than 35 languages and has been used in 180 countries.

Classroom teachers and specialist teachers (particularly in the junior school) have been using the Class Dojo app during Remote Learning to record lessons. Teachers will also be able to use this app to provide parents/guardians with (more recent) evidence of learning taking place in the classroom. The administration staff have also been able to use this app to send messages, latest updates and newsletters to parents/guardians.

The majority of our parents/guardians have already signed up for this app and are able to view information sent out by the school, directly onto their phone. If you need assistance with setting up Class Dojo, please contact Michael Bonnici at the office.

#### COMMUNICATION

Please note, that our Teaching Staff may not be able to respond to emails or telephone calls immediately. The school accepts that a response within 2 working days is acceptable. Our Parent Code of Conduct Policy stipulates that responses will not be made outside of working hours or during school holidays, with the exception of an emergency.

## **ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING**

All Victorian schools are required to provide a Semester 1 report. The Catholic Education Commission of Victoria (CECV) has worked with other sectors in Victoria to develop a consistent approach to the reporting of student achievement and progress. It has been agreed that Semester 1 reports are still required during remote and flexible learning, and schools should:

- •Provide a written report in an accessible form (print or digital) and easy for parents/carers to understand for Semester 1, 2020
- •Provide an opportunity for parents/carers and students to discuss the report with teachers
- •Include a commentary on student achievement and, where possible, progress.

Recognising that schools have adopted revised teaching and learning plans for Term 2, schools are required to provide:

- •A description of the areas of the Victorian Curriculum F–10 taught
- •A succinct descriptive assessment of student learning achievement, based on the Achievement Standards in the Victorian Curriculum F–10
- •A comment on how the student has adjusted to the remote and flexible learning environment, with reference to the 'Personal and Social Capability' curriculum.


### **CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)**
