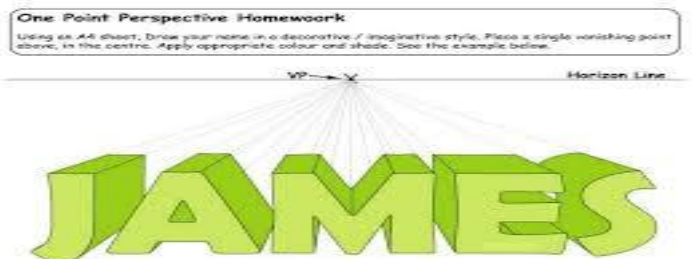

WEEK 7 GRADES 5 & 6

Learning Intention: This week we will learn about **technical art** and draw block letters to write our names, using one-point perspective. Also you will use tools for technical drawing i.e. a ruler, pencil, rubber, coloured pencils, markers and white paper, using line, shape, colour, tone and perspective, as well as learning the technical terms.



Step 1. Watch the video to get ideas on the techniques of writing your name in block letters and fitting it on an A4 size paper

Step 2. Fold your paper in half and put a cross right on top on the middle crease line.

Step 3. Write your own name in block letters, by centering it on the crease line, then square the letters using your ruler.

Step 4. Join all the letters of your name with a converging or vanishing line to the vanishing point or the point X.

Step 5. Use your ruler to draw the lines and colour the spaces using tone for 3D Effects. Look at the above examples.
