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WHAT IS A CARICATURE?

A **caricature** is a painting, or more usually drawing, of a person or thing in which the features and form have been distorted and exaggerated in order to ridicule or poke fun at the subject or use for a purpose such as entertainment.

Learning Intention: As part of wellbeing and mindfulness, you are asked to create a characterful collage by following a process.

1. You will use magazines to cut out facial features like the mouth, nose, ears and eyes.
2. Stick these down by using a blob of BluTack or masking tape on the back of the cut out features on the paper.
3. Next, use your pencil to copy the outlines around the cut out features to create your own caricatures.
4. You can colour these if you wish to enhance the character.
