Learning Intention: TRANSFORMING A NAME INTO A SYMMETRICAL CREATURE... ENJOY!!

- Step 1. Fold an A4 paper in half lengthwise.
- Step 2. Use a soft pencil and the line needs to be nice and thick.
- Step 3. Write your name on the inside of the folded paper in cursive or print.
- Step 4. Close your paper and use the closed lid of a marker or Sharpie to rub over the pencil line.
 - You will be rubbing on the back of the side of the paper that has no image.
 - You should be able to see through that one layer of paper to see where your lines are.
- Step 5. Once the name image is transferred, you have this weird, awesome symmetrical shape. Set your imagination loose as you add parts, patterns, and pieces to turn your design into an imaginary creature.
