**Learning Intention:** This week you will be experimenting painting with coffee, found in your kitchen. You will discover the various possibilities of painting without the use of colours, as well as experiencing the beautiful aroma to satisfy your senses. (see, hear, smell and feel)

The materials you will need are:

Thin and (thick brush) optional

Coffee granules mixed with a small amount of water to get 3 shades (light, medium and dark)

3 small containers to hold coffee granules

A4 paper

- Step 1. Please watch the video first to get ideas and get into the feel of it
- Step 2. Follow the tutorial. You can stop and start anytime you like
- Step 3. Take a thin brush and create branches on a tree
