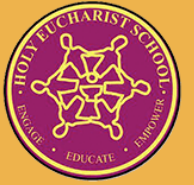

RELIGION

Unit: The Power Of Story

Understandings:

- The Bible is a sacred book which is a collection of stories about God and God's people.
- We learn about God's hope for us through the stories of the Old Testament and the teachings of Christ in the New Testament.
- Jesus taught us how to live in the image of God, as disciples of Christ, through his parables and miracles.
- Interpreting Bible stories involves listening, thinking and responding through our actions.

Unit: Sacred Times for the Catholic Church

Understandings:

- The Liturgical year celebrates the sacred mysteries of the birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus.
- The five meditations in the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary help us to remember the wonderful triumphs in Jesus' life.
- During the season of Advent and Christmas we celebrate the coming of Christ.
- Mary trusted in God's call for her to become Jesus Christ's mother, just as we are called to discipleship in our relationship with God.
- Rituals and celebrations are an important part of our identity and culture involving gifts of love, giving thanks and symbols.

ENGLISH

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Reading and exploring the structure of fairy tales.
- Participating in small group activities to develop reading skills.
- Developing their skills to decode written texts.
- Participating in comprehension activities around texts.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Planning and writing narratives using appropriate text features.
- Encouraged to spell unfamiliar words using the strategies taught in class.
- Supported in revising their own work.
- Encouraged to use correct letter formation when writing.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Presenting their narratives to the class.
- Encouraged to listen to the speaker.
- Supported to actively participate in circle time.
- Practising reading using fluency and correct phrasing.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

- Reading, writing and counting numbers to different points.
- Selecting simple questions and gathering appropriate responses for data collection.
- Interpreting data by classifying objects or people and creating tally charts and picture graphs.
- Describes the chance of something occurring using appropriate vocabulary.

INTEGRATED STUDES - INQUIRY

Topic: May The Forces Be With You

Learning Area: Physical Science

Big Question:

- What factors affect how objects move?
- What produces light and sound?

Understandings:

- A push or a pull affects how an object moves or changes shape.
- Light and sound are produced by a range of sources and can be sensed.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Learning how to follow simple rules and demonstrate fair play when participating in physical activities.
- Developing their locomotor movement skills such as running and jumping, and incorporating them in a variety of different team based games.
- Developing their hand-eye coordination and fundamental motor skills in basketball, such as dribbling and chest pass.

THE ARTS

Visual Arts

Your child will be:

- Reinforcing skills and knowledge gained during 'on line learning' and evaluating artworks.
- Exploring and expressing through the subject matter in the visual artworks they create.
- Experimenting, manipulating and gaining skills with different materials, art processes, techniques to make artworks with light and shadow.

Music

(This term will be a revision of concepts covered this year)

Your child will be:

- Identifying basic beat and rhythm within songs, chants, and instrumental pieces.
- Identifying differences in sound colour (timbre).
- Identifying patterns in music.
- Creating sound patterns using basic beat and rhythm.
- Developing performance skills through rehearsal of chosen Christmas song.
- Composing basic musical pieces using a variety of sound types, rhythm patterns and sound patterns.

LOTE - Language Other Than English

Chinese – Mandarin

Your child will be:

- Engaging with the traditions and customs, festivals, celebrations of Chinese communities.
- Matching characters to the meanings and sounds of familiar words, including family members and colours.
- Learning and creating simple informative sentences in Chinese.
- Writing and counting the Chinese numbers from 1—20.

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Your child will be:

- Learning about the different parts of computers and what they are used for.
- Learning how to keep safe while using digital devices.
- Exploring patterns in data and representing data as pictures, symbols and diagrams.
