HOLY EUCHARIST SCHOOL IN 2021 – GRADE PREP

ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING – SEMESTER 2

On Friday 4th December 2020 parents/carers will receive their child's formal report as well as their child's Assessment Portfolio. The work samples inside the portfolio are collected by the teacher as evidence of what has been taught during the term. These samples support what has been documented in the topic outline and should be looked at in conjunction with your child's report.

Assessment Portfolios will need to be signed and returned to school by Wednesday 9th December. The classroom teacher will pass these folders onto next year's teacher. All work samples collected during the year will be placed inside a Holy Eucharist Assessment envelope and given to you to keep.



HOLY EUCHARIST SCHOOL IN 2020 AND 2021

The last day for Term 4, 2020 will be on Tuesday 15th December 2020, at 2pm. School will resume for Term 1 in 2021, on Thursday 28th January 2021. As of next year, our starting times and finishing times will return to normal, however, students will still be required to enter via the designated gates. Please see below:

- 8:30am Gates open
- 8:45am Students enter the classroom
- 8:55am Classes begin
- 3:15pm School finishes

Students from each grade level will still need to enter via the designated gates around the school when entering/leaving the premises. The gates for each level are as follows:

- Gate 1 (Next to the hall) – Grade Prep and Grade 3
- Gate 2 (Next to the church) – Grade 1 and Grade 4
- Gate 3 (Admin gate) – Grades 6
- Gate 4 (O'Brien Drive) - Grade 2 and Grade 5

STUDENTS WHO ARE UNWELL

Please remember that if your child is feeling unwell, please keep them at home. Students will be sent home if they present with symptoms such as a sore throat, temperature, tiredness, loss of taste or smell, tummy pains or shortness of breath. It is important that your emergency contact is available, particularly, if you are unable to pick up your child when we ring you. **The constant message is for all of us to be responsible in the actions we take.** By keeping yourself safe, you are keeping your families, your colleagues and your friends safe.

SCHOOL HATS IN TERM 4

There are still quite a number of students at our school who do not have a school hat. In Australia we have "one of the highest rates of melanoma diagnoses in the world...two in three Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer by the age of 70" (SunSmart, 2019). The good news is that almost all skin cancers are preventable. In Term 4 all students and teachers are required to wear a hat when they are outside. It is an expectation and school policy that all students **wear their school hat and their correct school uniform at all times**. If students are not wearing the correct uniform they are required to have a written letter from their parents explaining why they are out of uniform. Please note: If students are **not wearing the correct school uniform, a note will be sent home** informing the parent/guardian. This note will need to be signed by the parent/guardian and the **name of the student will be recorded at the school office**.



Important information for families of students commencing Year 5 in 2021 who are interested in applying to attend a Catholic Secondary School commencing in 2023.



The key application and enrolment dates for students enrolled in Year 5 in 2021 who will be starting Year 7 in 2023 are as follows:

- 27 January 2021: Applications will open for Year students starting Year 7 in 2023.
- 20 August 2021: Applications will close.
- 22 October 2021: Offers will be posted to prospective Year 7 applicants.
- 12 November 2021: Final date for parents/carers to accept offer made by school
