Write down your point of view on the following topics.






Magoo wants to eat at the table and ride in the car. What human things does your dog like to do?







  - 4. How did you make the plate long? What did you do?
  - 5. How do you know that you have made the longest plate?
  - 6. Did you plan what you were going to do first or did you just do it?
  - 7. Did you have fun?
  - 8. What did this activity teach you?

Today, let someone outside of your family know you are grateful for their hard work:






