Step 1: After doing some research about the Rosary, **develop** one wondering question or topic sentence that you would like to respond to about the Rosary. Provide your chosen question/topic to your teacher.

Some ideas include:

- How to pray the Rosary;
- The origins of the Rosary;
- The Mysteries of the Rosary explained.
- About a particular Mystery of the Rosary;
- What prayers make up the Rosary?;
- What do the different prayers mean in the Rosary?
- Why the Rosary is used in the Catholic tradition;
- Other traditions that use similar ideas to the Rosary;
- How to use the Rosary as a form of Christian Meditation;
- Make a Rosary set and explain the different parts of it;
- About Mary our Mother and how she helps people today;
- Rosary beads how they are used?;
- How Rosary beads came about;
- Why people should pray the Rosary.

Step 2: Research more information to help you to respond to your wondering question/topic.

Step 3: Creatively present your question/topic research as information in your own words.

- As a Poster (A4 or A3);
- As a letter to someone (One page);
- Using a Slideshow to present to an audience (3-4 Slides maximum);
- As a speech (One page);
- Through an Art display (take a photograph and provide a blurb about your Art);
- By making a 3D object (eg: statue, rosary beads, symbol) which includes a short description (submit photograph of object and description).

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

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
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Term 4 Week 2: DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY: e-Safety
