MACS Flowchart for Expulsion of Students



Grounds for Expulsion

- ☐ behaves in such a way as to pose a danger – whether actual, perceived or threatened – to the health, safety or wellbeing of any person
- ☐ causes significant damage to or destruction of property
- ☐ commits, attempts to commit or is knowingly involved in theft of property
- ☐ possesses, uses or sells, or deliberately assists another person to possess, use or sell illicit substances or weapons
- ☐ fails to comply with any clear and reasonable instruction of a staff member so as to pose a danger – whether actual, perceived or threatened – to the health, safety or wellbeing of any person
- ☐ consistently engages in behaviour that vilifies, defames or humiliates another
- ☐ consistently behaves in an unproductive manner that interferes with the wellbeing, safety or educational opportunities of another student

Determining the Appropriateness of Expulsion

Considerations Prior to Issuing an Expulsion

- ☐ Principal to inform MACS Regional General Manager, including if the student is from a vulnerable cohort
- ☐ Principal to convene a Behaviour Support and Intervention Meeting with support from MACS Regional General Manager

Do not pursue expulsion

School-based action:

**Consider negotiated
transfer**

Decision to proceed with expulsion

- ☐ Principal to provide *Notice of Expulsion* to parents/guardians/carers/relevant persons and MACS Regional General Manager
- ☐ Principal to ensure student is enrolled in another school or alternative setting as soon as practicable
