STARTING AND FINISHING TIMES.

Students in **Grade Prep** will start school at 8:55am and finish at 1pm next week (Week 2).

Students in Grade 1 and Grade 2 start school at 8:55am and finish at 3:10pm.

Students in Grades 3 to Grade 6 start school at 8:55am and finish at 3:15pm.

•Parents/carers will need to collect their Prep child from the classroom at 1pm.

Week Beginning Monday 13th February 2023

•As of Monday 13th February, the Preps are full time and will finish school at 3:10pm. •Prep parents/carers will need to collect their child from their classroom.

GATES

Since the construction of our new building, our staff are now required to park on the rounders court. Temporary fencing has been installed on the rounders court to keep students safe and away from cars.

For the time being, the pedestrian gate next to the hall (i.e. GATE 1, Gr Prep and Gr 3) <u>will be</u> <u>permanently closed</u>. Grade Prep will now need to enter/leave via the Church gate (GATE 2) and Grade 3 will need to enter/leave via the Administration gate (GATE 3).

Please remember:

- Gates will open for students at 8:30am
- Classrooms will open at 8:45am
- All students will start school at 8:55am
- Grade Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2 will finish school at 3:10pm. Grade 3, Grade 4, Grade 5 and Grade 6 will finish at 3:15pm

NB: If there is more than one child in the family, parents/carers can use one gate to drop off and pick up their children (as long as one child from the family is from the year level specified on the gate. The same gate must be used for pick-up).

SCHOOL HATS IN TERM 4

There are still guite a number of students at our school who do not have a school hat. In Australia we have "one of the highest rates of melanoma diagnoses in the world...two in three Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer by the age of 70" (SunSmart, 2019). The good news is that almost all skin cancers are preventable. It is recommended that staff and students use a combination of sun protection measures (i.e. sun hat, sunscreen, clothing, shade and sunglasses when outdoors, avoid deliberate and extended sun exposure) when UV index levels are 3 or above (generally from mid-August to the end of April in Victoria). In Term 1 and Term 4 all students and teachers are required to wear a hat when they are outside. It is an expectation and school policy that all students wear their school hat and their

PARKING AROUND THE SCHOOL PREMISES

Brimbank Council are issuing fines to people who were not obeying the law. The school is not authorised to cancel your parking infringements and will not pay for these!!!

GRADE PREP TESTING

At the beginning of the 2023 school year, the Prep teachers at Holy Eucharist School will be conducting Literacy and Numeracy assessments. In order to lessen the disruption to learning, we have allocated 30-minute sessions for your child to complete a series of tests. The information obtained from these assessments will be used to help your child's learning throughout the year.

All Prep parents/carers should have received their interview time by now. Testing is compulsory for all students at the beginning and end of each year. Results are submitted to Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools. As such, attendance at this testing is essential.

The Prep students are only required to be at school for 30 minutes to complete their testing. When the testing is completed, the students must return home. Please ensure children are not left unsupervised at school. We thank you for your support and cooperation.

NEW BUILDING




