### Your child will be:

- Learning to take turns and raise their hand before speaking.

### Your child will be:

- Counting forwards and backwards in the range to 20 and beyond.
- Recognising, naming and ordering numerals.
- Stating the days of the week.
- Sorting, describing and naming two-dimensional shapes.
- Answering simple yes/no questions to collect information.

### Your child will be:

- Using their voice, movement and facial expressions to create different characters with different emotions.
- Acting out well known stories and Fairytales.
- Exploring pitch and rhythm by singing and playing along to well known Nursery Rhymes.

### Your child will be:

- Responding to familiar games and routines such as questions about self. e.g. What is your name? How are you?
- Recognising, tracing and copying simple Italian words and phrases.
- Using Italian to communicate verbally and non-verbally through songs and action related talk and play. e.g. Greetings and numbers song.
