RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Unit: The Easter Season

Understandings:

- On Easter Sunday Christians celebrate Jesus Christ being alive in a new way.
- After his resurrection Jesus Christ appeared to his disciples on the road to Emmaus.
- The Ascension celebrates Jesus Christ's return to the Father.
- At Pentecost, the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit, the spirit of Jesus.

Unit: Our Relationship with God and Others

Understandings:

- The relationships in our lives are important.
- Jesus teaches people to love one another as he loves them.
- Being a good friend involves saying sorry and forgiving.
- Jesus Christ healed people in need.
- It is important to say thank you to God and others.

<u>ENGLISH</u>

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Exploring the features of non-fiction texts.
- Reading non-fiction texts to gather information.
- Using their knowledge of sounds and blends to solve unknown words.
- Learning words that have the same spelling patterns.
- Recognising words from the same word family and words that rhyme.
- Participating in small group activities to further develop reading skills.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Planning and writing an Information Report using appropriate text features.
- Proofreading and editing their own work.
- Attempting to spell unfamiliar words using the strategies taught in class.
- Practicing correct letter formation on dotted thirds.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Encouraged to listen to the speaker.
- Pronouncing words correctly.
- Answering questions in full sentences.
- Practising reading using fluency and correct phrasing.
- Sharing things of interest during "Show and Tell" time.
- Presenting an Information Report to the class.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

- Choosing simple questions and gathering responses.
- Representing data with objects and drawings where one object or drawing represents one data value.
- Measuring and comparing the lengths and masses of pairs of objects using uniform informal units.
- Representing and solving simple addition and subtraction problems using a range of strategies including counting on, partitioning and rearranging parts.
- Investigating and describing number patterns formed by skip counting and patterns made with objects.

INQUIRY

Topic: Life Cycles

- Learning Area: Biological Science Big Question: What is a life cycle? Understandings:
- All living things go through a life cycle.
- A life cycle has stages from birth to death.
- Living things have different life cycles (i.e. a human life cycle is different from a caterpillar's).
- Living things have different needs to survive.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Demonstrating balance and describing what helps to maintain a stable position.
- Performing fundamental movement skills involving controlling objects with different parts of the body.
- Developing their movement and hand-eye coordination skills through different games and activities.

<u>THE ARTS</u>

Visual Arts Your child will be:

- Learning about the artist Claude Monet as the master of Impressionism.
- Investigating the use of light and reflection when composing an Impressionist artwork.
- Expressing their own feelings and emotions by creating Impressionist artworks, using various brush stroke techniques.

Performing Arts

Your child will be:

- Learning how to express music using symbols and notations and using the correct terminology to discuss the elements of music (rhythm, pitch, tempo and dynamics).
- Developing performance skills by working in an ensemble as a member of a drumming circle.

LOTE - Language Other Than English - Italian

Your child will be:

- Sharing information about themselves.
- Learning to recognise the 21 letters of the Italian alphabet.
- Participating in shared action with peers and teachers through images, movement and song.

• Learning about road safety and transport: "Mezzi di trasporto".

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Your child will be:

- Using an online paint program to experiment with various tools;
- Creating symmetrical images using an online painting program;
- Practising keyboard and typing skills.
