RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Unit: Jesus is Alive

- Your child will be learning:
- That God is our protector.
- The main parts of the story of the burial and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- The main parts of the Pentecost story.

Unit: Relationships

Your child will be learning:

- That Jesus grew up in a family and we can read stories about his childhood in the Bible.
- About how people in the Old Testament guide and protect us.
- About the location, characters and events of the scripture story of the birth of Moses.

<u>ENGLISH</u>

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Recognising the difference between upper and lower-case letters.
- Identifying and reading some high frequency words.
- Using a variety of reading strategies when reading texts.
- Sequencing the events of simple stories and rhymes verbally and through pictures.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Attempting to write upper and lower-case letters using the correct letter formation.
- Listening for and recording initial letters when attempting to write words.
- Attempting to write on the solid line and using finger spacing between words.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Listening and speaking to communicate ideas.
- Asking and answering simple questions.
- Sharing personal experiences.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

- Counting forwards and backwards from different starting points.
- Recognising numerals and collections to 10 and beyond.
- Using everyday objects to measure informally.
- Comparing and describing objects using everyday language such as longer and shorter.

INQUIRY

Topic: Human Growth Over Time Learning Area: Science - Biological Sciences Big Question: What does it mean to change? Understandings:

- People change over time.
- People grow in height and weight.
- People go through stages of growth from a baby to an elderly person.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Continuing to follow instructions to keep themselves and others safe during physical activities.
- Participating in games that require students to be aware of personal safety and game boundaries.
- Learning new activities and describing how they felt about the experience.

THE ARTS

Visual Arts Your child will be:

- Viewing and responding to videos on artworks created by Claude Monet.
- Learning about the meaning of the word Impressionism.
- Exploring the importance of using brush strokes to create light effects in their artworks.
- Experimenting with art tools and materials such as using dyes on soft paper and other surfaces to compare special visual art effects.

Performing Arts

Your child will be:

- Learning about the elements of music, including steady beat and rhythm, tempo (fast and slow) and pitch (high and low).
- Exploring different percussion instruments to create music and participate in African Drumming using the traditional djembes.

LOTE - Language Other Than English - Italian

Your child will be:

- Responding to familiar games and routines such as questions about self. E.g. What is your name? How are you? What colour do you like?
- Sharing information about themselves.
- Recognising, tracing and copying simple Italian words and phrases.
- Using Italian to communicate verbally and non-verbally through songs, gestures and action related talk and play. E.g. Greetings, numbers and body parts song.

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Your child will:

- Practising mousepad and keyboard skills.
- Continuing to experiment with basic coding.
- Using a paint program to display data.
