RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Unit: How Deep Is Your Life

Understandings:

- People feel close to God in different ways, in different places and at different times.

<u>ENGLISH</u>

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Reading and identifying structural and language features of narrative texts.
- Using comprehension strategies such as visualising and making inferences to support their understanding of texts.
- Using reading strategies such as monitoring meaning, re-reading and self-correcting to read unfamiliar texts and improve fluency.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Exploring a range of narratives to compare and contrast characters and settings in different texts.
- Planning, drafting, editing and publishing narrative texts.
- Applying their knowledge of letter sound patterns to spell familiar and unfamiliar words.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Participating in Reader's Theatre to develop their oral fluency when reading aloud and using varied intonation and speed.
- Encouraged to listen to the speaker, and use a clear voice when participating in small groups and class discussions.
- Following instructions and listening for information in different contexts and for various purposes.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

- Measuring the length and area of objects using informal units.
- Recognising and representing multiplication as repeated addition, groups and arrays.
- Recognising and representing division as grouping into equal sets and solving simple problems using learnt strategies.
- Recognising and interpreting halves, quarters and eighths.

Topic: Always Take the Weather With You

Learning Area: Science and Geography

Big Question: How do changes in the weather affect living things and our everyday lives? Understandings:

- Seasons are a way of recognising changes in the environment.
- The weather affects the way we live, our lifestyles, and our emotions.
- Different places around the world have different weather patterns/seasons.
- Weather has an impact on the appearance of a landscape.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Developing their hand-eye coordination skills and movement by playing Mini-Scoops and modified versions of Tee-ball.
- Continuing to develop their ability to scoop, point and throw a ball with direction and force, as well as applying this skill to other based games and activities.
- Participating in games that use a number of different fundamental movement skills such as sprinting, balancing and striking.

THE ARTS

Visual Arts

Your child will be:

- Making a leaf tealight lamp using materials from nature.
- Incorporating techniques and processes to make a four-sided lamp.
- Applying principles of design including ironing, rolling, sticking, and other fine motor skills.

Performing Arts

Your child will be:

- Learning and performing cultural songs to an audience.
- Exploring possibilities for dramatic action, roles and situations by participating in process drama, and discussing their choices as a group.

<u>Italian</u>

Your child will be:

- Sharing with others what they can express in Italian about themselves, family members and friends.
- Reviewing numbers 1-20 and expressing their age.
- Participating in classroom routines, games, instructions and shared activities.
