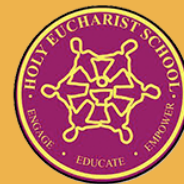

RELIGION

Unit: Life is Good

Understandings:

- God's creation is good. God creates each person with dignity and the fifth commandment teaches people to respect life.
- God invites people to be responsible for the life that has been given to them. Therefore, an important part of being christian is to respect and look after our bodies and minds.
- To live out the fifth commandment, the Catholic Church has organisations that care for people's mental and physical wellbeing.

ENGLISH

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Reading a variety of information and narrative texts and identifying their structural and language features.
- Identifying how socio – cultural values, attitudes and beliefs are presented in texts.
- Learning that many complex words are formed using prefixes and suffixes.
- Reading and responding to the novel 'Boy Overboard' by Morris Gleitzman.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Planning, drafting and publishing an information report and narrative text.
- Proof-reading own written text.
- Writing for a particular audience.
- Practicing taking notes and rephrasing information in their own words.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Varying tone, volume and pace of speech for an effective oral presentation.
- Participating in oral interactions for different purposes, for example, entertaining, informing and influencing others.
- Attentively listening to spoken texts and accurately retelling key information.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

LENGTH

- Using units of measurement.
- Calculating the perimeter and area of rectangles using familiar metric units.

TIME

- Comparing 12- and 24-hour time systems and converting between them.

MULTIPLICATION

- Solving problems involving multiplication of single and multi-digit numbers.

DIVISION

- Solving problems involving division by a one-digit number, including those that result in a remainder.

FRACTIONS AND DECIMALS

- Investigating strategies to solve problems involving addition and subtraction of fractions with the same denominator.
- Comparing, ordering and representing decimals.
- Describing, continuing and creating patterns with fractions, decimals and whole numbers resulting from addition and subtraction.

INTEGRATED STUDIES - INQUIRY

Topic: Earth Science

Learning Area: Science and Geography

Big Questions: How does the sun influence the Solar System? How do natural disasters affect the environment and the community?

Understandings:

- Earth is part of a system of planets orbiting around the Sun.
- The sun is the most important part in our Solar System.
- There are different planets and each has different characteristics.
- The planets have different characteristics based on their distance from and their orbit around the sun.
- Sudden geological changes or extreme weather conditions can affect earth's surface.
- Today's actions in the environment influence present and future generations.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Participating positively in groups and teams by encouraging others and negotiating roles and responsibilities during different physical activities.
- Performing activities that involve a transition from one skill to another, such as from dribbling to shooting or from leaping to balancing.
- Refining their techniques for different Athletics events in preparation for the Grade 3-6 Athletics Day in Term 3.

THE ARTS

Visual Arts

Your child will be:

- Creating a textile tree, incorporating a metal or cardboard ring for weaving.
- Using elements of art to select coloured threads and designing a Claude Monet Garden scene.
- Using fine motor skills including twisting, tying knots and weaving.

Performing Arts

Your child will be:

- Exploring how to add tension and empathy to their drama by exploring complex themes using Process Drama.
- Use digital technologies to create a backing track to accompany an original rap they create.

LOTE - Language Other Than English - Italian

Your child will be:

- Interacting in classroom activities and creating shared class routines.
- Using spoken and written Italian to describe and give information about themselves, family and friends.
- Creating imaginative texts using imaginary characters, places and ideas. E.g. Postcard from Italy and visiting famous Italian monuments and places of interest.

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Your child will be:

- Planning and creating a multimedia presentation using a graphic design app.
- Continuing to develop their coding skills using alternate coding websites.
- Exploring how to program an Edison robot.
