RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Unit: God Loves Us

Your child will be learning:

- Humans are created and loved by God.
- Humans are unique and can make their own choices.
- Bible stories teach us about God and Jesus.

ENGLISH

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Reading different types of texts, such as fairy tales, indigenous and other cultural stories.
- Exploring and understanding an author's purpose and the structure of different text types.
- Making personal connections to the text.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Recording letters to match sounds, including beginning and end sounds when attempting to spell and write words.
- Adding detail such as adjectives to their sentences.
- Learning the structure of Information Reports.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Listening to peers and reporting back.
- Speaking with expression in imaginative play.
- Retelling a story in chronological order.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

- Representing situations to model addition and subtraction problems.
- Representing sharing in practical situations.
- Comparing and ordering the duration of events.

INTEGRATED STUDIES - INQUIRY

Topic: Weather in My World

Learning Area: Earth Science

Big Question: How do we know when the weather changes?

Understandings:

- There are 4 seasons in Australia and they follow a cycle.
- Seasons affect living things.
- Weather is ever changing.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Developing their hand-eye coordination skills by playing modified versions of Mini-Tennis.
- Continuing to develop their awareness of personal safety and game boundaries to participate in games.
- Practising fundamental movement skills such as scoop, strike, catch and throw during different physical activities.

THE ARTS

Visual Arts

Your child will be:

- Introduced to paper weaving, using strips of textured and plain paper.
- Reconstructing Monet's Garden by creating a floral pattern in their weaving.
- Learning techniques and following instructions such as, under over rhythm of weaving, using a paper loom.

Performing Arts

Your child will be:

- Expanding their drama skills to include role-plays that reflect different emotions and have a beginning, middle and end.
- Responding to both drama and music by identifying what they enjoy and why, as well as reflecting on their own performances.

LOTE - Language Other Than English

Italian

Your child will be:

- Sharing information about themselves , family members and friends.
- Recognising, tracing and copying simple Italian words and phrases.
- Using Italian to communicate verbally through songs, gestures and action related talk and play. e.g. Greetings, numbers, seasons and weather.

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Your child will be:

- Continuing to practise mousepad and keyboard skills.
- Experimenting with basic coding.
- Introduced to basic hardware and software components of a computer.
