### **Understandings:**

- The Mysteries of the Rosary tell us about the life of Jesus and his Mother Mary

## Unit Title: Jesus is Born (Advent and Christmas)

# **Understandings:**

- People wait for many things
- Advent is a time of preparation, patience and joy
- During Christmas, the Church remembers and celebrates the birth of Jesus.

#### **ENGLISH**

### Reading and Viewing

#### Your child will be:

- Continuing to explore and understand the purpose and structure of different text types
- Encouraged to self-correct their reading
- Answering simple questions to show understanding of the text
- Segmenting and blending three and four letter words.

### **Writing**

#### Your child will be:

- Planning, drafting and publishing a short text
- Building a bank of words that they are able to read and spell
- Expanding on their ideas by writing more detailed sentences.

### Speaking and Listening

### Your child will be:

- Continuing to share personal experiences
- Using spoken language appropriately in a variety of situations
- Communicating and expressing themselves during imaginative play and Learning Centres.

### Your child will be:

- Representing practical situations to model sharing
- Making o'clock times on a clock face and using the everyday language of time
- Organising simple data into displays using objects and drawings.

## **Understandings:**

- We come together to celebrate with our family, community and friends

#### Your child will be:

- Practising fundamental movement skills such as kicking, catching and throwing during different physical activities and games.

#### Visual Arts

### Your child will be:

- Introduced to the Aboriginal culture and art by watching and discussing information in videos
- Learning about the traditional ochre colours used in Aboriginal art
- Creating Aboriginal inspired animal drawings, and learning skills of dot painting, using art tools to decorate.

# **Performing Arts**

#### Your child will be:

- Revising their understanding of pitch, tempo, beat and rhythm through voice work and actions
- Learning their chosen song for the Christmas concert and exploring movement as a way of responding to songs they sing.

### **LOTE - Language Other Than English - Italian**

#### Your child will be:

- Creating a Season poster of Spring including labels and captions using familiar Italian words and phrases
- Learning weather expressions through song and gestures
- Using Italian to communicate verbally through action related talk and play. e.g. Greetings, numbers, seasons and weather.

### DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

#### Your child will be:

- Learning how to login to their Google account with teacher support
- Identifying ways to stay safe online at home and at school
- Creating a Word document where they can add text and a picture.
