The First Sunday of Advent - Year A A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

Stay awake, you must be ready. (Matthew 24:37-44)

Jesus said to his disciples : 'As it was in Noah's day, so will it be when the Son of Man comes. For in those days before the Flood people were eating, drinking, taking wives, taking husbands, right up to the day Noah went into the ark, and they suspected nothing till the Flood came and swept all away. It will be like this when the Son of Man comes. Then of two men in the fields one is taken, one left; of two women at the millstone grinding, one is taken, one left. 'So stay awake, because you do not know the day when your master is coming. You may be quite sure of this that if the householder had known at what time of the night the burglar would come, he

would have stayed awake and would not have allowed anyone to break through the wall of his house. Therefore, you too must stand ready because the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.'

Let's reflect: The Season of Advent offers a pathway of peace through our busy and bustling lives, when, as a community, we are heading towards the end of our school year. At the same time, our Catholic identity calls for us to understand what Christ's birth represents for us: Hope, Love, Joy and Peace. Let us be enlightened by the Gospel so that together, we may radiate God's hope for humanity.

NEW LINE-UP AREAS: Before school and at the end of recess and lunch

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, our Preps and Year 1 classes have relocated to different classrooms in preparation for the refurbishment works, which are scheduled to begin early next year. With the majority of classes now situated at the back of the school, we have made some important changes to where students will be required to line up.

Effective immediately, students will no longer line up outside their classrooms before school, during recess, or at lunchtime. When the bell rings at 8:45am, students are to move directly to their designated line-up areas and wait for their teachers.

For safety reasons, no students or parents are permitted to wait outside classrooms or between buildings before school or during recess and lunch.

New Line-Up Locations:

• Prep, Year 1, Year 2, and Year 3:

Students will line up on the Basketball Court with their bags at 8:45am and whenever the bell rings at the end of recess and lunch.

Years 4, 5, and 6:

Students will line up on the Oval with their bags at 8:45am and whenever the bell rings at the end of recess and lunch.

These changes have been introduced to support smoother transitions, improve supervision, and enhance student safety. We appreciate your cooperation and support as we implement this new procedure.

For safety reasons, students are not permitted to play ball games on the oval or the basketball court before or after school.

Last Day of Term 4, 2025
